

## Land Claims MOA Resolution w/the Thames Band Council

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian

government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States,

and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida

Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of

Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the General

Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council has authorized funds to support the

Onyota' a:ka of the Thames land claims activities, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee desires that a "Memorandum of

Agreement" be entered into with the Onyota' a:ka of the Thames, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the following terms and conditions meet the criteria set forth by the Oneida General Tribal Council for the "Memorandum of Agreement."
