

RESOLUTION # 7-10-91-C

- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States; and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has been delegated authority under Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin through the Oneida Business Committee is the chief planning agency for community development activities on the Oneida Reservation; and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin wishes to assume more control over programs designed to serve its constituents and to generally diminish Federal domination over programs serving Tribal members; and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has demonstrated the ability to develop and implement comprehensive planning activities for the benefit of its members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin intends to contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to conduct a FY 1991 Planning Grant for the purpose of developing a Comprehensive Community Development Plan for the years 1992-96 as outlined in the attached proposal.
