RESOLUTION 7-11-79-A

WHEREAS: the Oneida Business Committee strongly supports the need for improved effectiveness and efficiency in tribal government, and

WHEREAS: a "position classification and compensation study" has been established as a priority need to bring about increased efficiency in tribal government, and

WHEREAS; Community Management Services of the State of Wisconsin, Department of Local Affairs and Development agrees to provide a technical assistance study upon tribal approval and agrees to assume one-half of the cost of the study if the tribe agrees to assume the other half.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee agrees to contract with Community Management Service for the completion of a classification and compensation study and that the Chairman of the Business Committee is authorized to sign the necessary contract documents.
