The Oneida Business Committee hereby grants to the applicant, the right to survey and assess value of the requested right of way, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that

The Superintendant, of the Great Lakes Agency, is hereby directed to inititate and prepare the necessary documents for said survey and assessment.
