RESOLUTION # 7-16-93-E

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the safety and welfare of Oneida families is a concern and responsibility of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and


WHEREAS, the Oneida Social Services Department has been established to promote stability and security of Tribal families, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has determined that a need for a strong link between health care services is needed to assure that proper and immediate care is received when needed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin make application to the Department of Health and Human Services Center for Substance Abuse Treatment under the "Linking Community-based Primary Care, Substance Abuse, HIV/AIDS, and Mental Health" grant program.
