

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Oneida Tribe to diversify its economy and the Starflex product is a diversification of the economy; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe Economic Development is expecting Starflex product to be shipped to Oneida from France, and
- WHEREAS JAS Forwarding (USA), Inc. will assist in getting the Starflex product to Oneida, Wisconsin, USA but requires a Master Customs Power of Attorney to complete this task; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee and Oneida Economic Development desire JAS Forwarding (USA), Inc. to act as its agent in the importation of the Starflex product.
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Business Committee authorizes the Chairwoman to sign the Master Customs Power of Attorney for JAS Forwarding (USA), inc. to act as the Oneida Tribe's agent in the importing of the Starflex product.
