

- WHEREAS, it is national policy to provide full Indian participation in the education of Indian people, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Nation is vitally concerned about the education of its youth, and
- WHEREAS, P.L. 93-638 allows Indian tribes to enter into a contract to plan, conduct, and administer education programs, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Nation wishes to continue administering the Tribal School and the following programs:
 - 1. Johnson O'Malley
- 638 Contract
 Title I
- Title IV, B and C
 Special Education
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tribal Chairman be authorized to sign the necessary contracting documents for FY 1932
