- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee, under its management system, reviews and approves all programs and services, and
- WHEREAS, the Assessment of "Caries Risk" in Native American Children and young adults proposal is consistent with Tribal goals and objectives,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians approves submission of the proposal to Indian Health Service.
