- WHEREAS, Joe Webster is in violation of his lease agreement wherein he has permitted non-tribal members to establish a mobile trailer on his lease agreement without the consent of the Oneida Business Committee, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe formally requests the Solicitors Office to investigate this matter for possible legal action and refer the case to the Justice Department if legal action is deemed necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this committee in <u>Kloulan</u> session assembled, hereby approves the investigation of the Joe Webster lease agreement by the Solicitors Office.
