WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin feels it is necessary to broaden the public awareness of historical and cultural events that have led the Tribe to where it is today, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin recognizes the need for continued growth in the knowledge of historical records of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has determined that it will sponsor an Oneida History Conference II, "The Buffalo Creek Treaty" in April, 1990.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe apply for a Public Hmanities Project Grant from the National Endowment of the Humanities.
