

Resolution No. S-14-78-A

WHEREAS, the GLITC, Inc., Alcoholism Program was established in 1970 to provide alcoholism programming for the ten Wisconsin Indian reservations under the umbrella of GLITC, Inc., and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe, as a member of GLITC, Inc., has been receiving continuous service from the GLITC, Inc., since 1970, and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 1979, the GLITC, Inc., Alcoholism Program is scheduled to transfer from the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism to the Indian Health Service, and

WHEREAS, the GLITC, Inc., intends to negotiate a contract with IHS under the terms of P.L. 93-638; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe authorizes the GLITC, Inc., Alcoholism Program to negotiate a P.L. 93-638 contract with the Indian Health Service to provide total alcoholism programming, including outreach services, education information consultation services, referral services and outpatient services for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee, hereby certify that the Oneida Business Committee is composed of 9 members of whom 5 members, constituting a quorum, were present at a meeting duly called, noticed and held on the 14th day of August 1978, that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by a vote of 5 members for, 0 members against, 5 members not voting; and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
