RESOLUTION # 8-17-90-D

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, it is the policy of locality to eliminate sub-standard and other inadequate housing, the Oneida Business Committee has reviewed the alternative of Land Acquisition, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee does agree that there is a need to provide housing for their citizens, and
- WHEREAS, the method of Land Acquisition will allow citizens of the Oneida Tribe the opportunity to have homes within the boundaries of the reservation bought and brought up to standard.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Business Committee does hereby agree to the method of Land Acquisition.
