RESOLUTION # 8-18-93 B

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, to manage all the economic affairs and enterprises of the Oneida Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as: Vanden Eng Property

A parcel of land located in the Southwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4, the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4, the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4, The Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 and the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4, all in Section 25 and part of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 26 and Government Lots: 21, 22 and 23 in Section 26, all in Township 23 North, Range 18 East, Town of Oneida, Outagamie County, Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows: Commencing at the North 1/4 corner of Section 25; thence S 00°09'14"E, 50.01 feet along the East line of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 25 to the South right-of-way line of C.T.H. "EE" and the point of beginning; thence continuing S 00°09'14" E, 2584.48 feet along said East line to the center of Section 25; thence S 88°32'01"W, 1311.95 feet along the East-West 1/4 line of Section 25 to the East line of the West 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 25; thence S 00°21'50" E, 1782.35 feet along said East line to the North line of lands described in Volume 770, page 627; thence S 89°22'29" W, 467.97 feet (recorded as S 89°41' E, 467.36 feet) along said North line; thence N 49°33'54" W, 632.23 feet (recorded as S 49°42' E 646.25 feet) along a North-easterly line of said described lands; thence S 88°54'32" W, 654.13 feet (recorded as N 89°58' E, 635.06 feet) along the North line of said described lands; thence S 34°21'03" W, 879.90 feet (recorded as N 35°29' E 879.60 feet) along the Northwesterly line of said described lands; thence S 00°29'31" E, 570.43 feet (recorded as N 0°25' E 570.65 feet) along the West line of said described lands to the South line of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 26; thence S 89°00'31" W, 532.87 feet along said South line to the Southwest corner of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 26; thence N 00°21'43" W, 3106.03 feet along the West line of said Southeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 26 and the West line of Government Lots: 21, 22, and 23 of Section 26 as evidenced and occupied; thence N 89°02'22" E, 1321.51 feet along the North line of Government Lot 21 to the West line of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 25; thence S 00°22'17" E, 109.39 feet along said West line; thence N 88°35'06" E, 669.92 feet; thence N 00°39'43" E, 963.49 feet to the North line of the Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 25; thence N 88°55'53" E, 627.07 feet along said North line as evidenced and occupied to the West line of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 25; thence N 00°15'55" W, 425.24 feet along said West line to the South line of Certified Survey Map No. 1325 as recorded in Volume 7 of Certified Survey Maps on page 1325; thence N 88°38'00" E, 990.00 feet along said South line to the East line of said Certified Survey Map No. 1325; thence N 00°15'55" W, 411.21 feet along said East line; thence N 88°38'00" E, 200.00 feet; thence N 00°15'55" W, 435.68 feet to the South right-of-way line of C.T.H. "EE"; thence N 88°38'00" E, 126.81 feet along said South line to the point of beginning.



WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes will be paid up to trust placement, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcel in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
