RESOLUTION # 8-18-93 J

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Leland Ninham and Sandra Doxtator Ninham are holders of lease no. B-491(68), described as follows:

South two (2) acres of the West seven (7) acres of the East thirty (30) acres of the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 2, Township 23 North, Range 19 East, 4th P.M., Wisconsin, subject to valid rights-of-way of record.

WHEREAS, Leland and Sandra Doxtator Ninham Lessee(s), that Lease No B-491(68) wish to modify their lease as follows:


Delete: Leland Ninham and/or Sandra Doxtator Ninham, his wife

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee in Regular Session assembled, hereby approves the *MODIFICATION of Lease no. B-491(68),

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease *MODIFICATION documents for and in behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
