

RESOLUTION NO. 8-19-92-E

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV as amended, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as: BLASCZYK PROPERTY.

A parcel of land located in part of government Lot 21, Section 29, Township 24 North, Range 20 East, City of Green Bay, Brown County, Wisconsin described as follows:

Commencing at the West One-Quarter corner of said Section 29, thence SO $^{\circ}$ -11'-06" E 100.00 feet; thence N 89 $^{\circ}$ -48'-54" E 926.18 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing N 89 $^{\circ}$ -48'-54" E along the South line of West Mason Street Frontage Road 120.00 feet; thence S O $^{\circ}$ -14'-42" W 263.00 feet thence N 89 $^{\circ}$ -48'-54" W 120.00 feet; thence N O $^{\circ}$ -14'-42" E 263.00 feet to the point of beginning and subject to easements and reservations of record.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcel in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
