



RESOLUTION NO. 8-19-92-K

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV as amended, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as: PHILIPSEN PROPERTY.

A parcel of land located in all of Government Lots 13, 14 and 15 and all of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 and in part of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 33, Township 24 North, Range 19 East, Town of Oneida, Outagamie Wisconsin described as follows: Commencing at Outagamie County Monument marking the South 1/4 corner of Section 33, said corner also being the point of beginning; thence South 88°-36'-58" West 63.10 feet; thence North 88°-35'-37" 1,252.46 feet; thence North 00-16'-40" West, 1,231.41 feet; thence North 00-15'-48" West, 1,330.34 feet; thence North 00-08'-10" West, 1,313.92 feet; thence South 890-42'-11" East, 1,316.39 feet; thence South 00-03'-37" East, 1,307.62 feet; thence South 0°-15'-53" East, 1,333.15 feet; thence South 0°-17'-40" East 1,257.27 feet to the point of beginning and containing 5,113,088 square feet, more or less.

WHEREAS, The above described parcel is requested in trust status to expand Oneida Tribal land base and provide a future site for economic development, Conservation and Light Industrial and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes will be paid up to trust placement, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcel in trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
