RESOLUTION NO. 8- Z2-82-6

- WHEREAS, A memorandum from the Geophysicist, Energy and Minerals Division, Lakewood, Colorado, dated February 2, 1982, indicates that Oneida has "good potential for lead-zinc deposits"; and,
- WHEREAS, A memorandum from the Area Director, Minneapolis Area Office dated February 23, 1982 requires a Tribal Resolution supporting the proposed exploration; and,
- WHEREAS, On March 15, 1982, the Oneida Business Committee adopted a Resolution requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs to proceed with Phase II of the research plan to evaluate the economic potential of findings; and,
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe at that time had little knowledge of the impact of mining exploration and operation on the health, safety and welfare of the residents in a mining area; and,

WHEREAS,

The Oneida Tribe has since learned that the lack of knowledge, skills and technology of government agencies, residents and mining operators to adequately protect the health, safety and welfare of residents of mining areas has created a negative impact on the Tribe's willingness to proceed with mining exploration.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the resolution dated March 15, 1982, to permit further mining exploration on the Oneida Reservation be and is hereby rescinded.
