For the record:

Brandon Steven stated this is a burdensome process, the pardon process and I think it needs to be restrictive and it needs to have a clear distinction of what we're looking for regarding criteria, to have validity. We don't want to just be signing pardons left and right, but we want to make sure that the people are going through the process, they understand the process, it's communicated to them and they know where to go. I think it does need to be within the Chair and Vice Chair's office because you guys are the leaders and signing off on that would entail that you are granting them clemency or pardon. We do it for certain reasons, for housing. We have a long housing list of people. We have good applicants. We have applicants that are really trying hard and we have applicants that just want a pardon, just so that they can get housing and then there's a whole line of people who are good qualified people and we're just thinking about those who just want a pardon, just to get housing. Sometimes they get that misrepresentation that just because they get a pardon, they're going to get a house and so that's why we have to make it clear to them that just because they are getting a pardon, it just allows them to be on the list to be employed. It allows them on the list to get housing, that it doesn't push them forward.

For the record:

Patty Hoeft stated the new pardon and forgiveness law is more restrictive to the applicants, not to the Tribe. It makes it very difficult for applicants to go through the process. Then it makes it very difficult for the agencies such as the Gaming Commission and HR to do their work because the applicant will go through various processes and when they come through us first, we are taking action to nullify their record. Which is good for the applicant.

For the record:

Ed Delgado stated I brought this forward because right now we have no process and we have a lot of people who are seeking pardons. 25 years ago, when I came here I was shocked at the number of Oneidas in the Brown County jail and Outagamie jail. I was really shocked because our people are identified by those officers in Green Bay and Ashwaubenon and we have a high, high percentage of people with records. Whereas those other people they are not targeted. Caucasian Americans are not targeted, but our people are. We have a lot of people with records and we need to somehow welcome them back to our community, because that is part of who we are. We have a long history in our traditions about people who change, from the Tadadaho all the way to Handsome Lake. Thank you.
