

- WHEREAS, the majority of the Oneida Tribal members (approximately 3000) reside in Brown and Outagamie Counties, and
- WHEREAS, the present Wisconsin Judicare program does not encompass the counties of Brown and Outagamie, and
- WHEREAS, there is a great need for legal representation of individual Tribal members because of lack of funds and lack of knowledge of the law and order system, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Business Committee is not provided with nor has available representation in matters of contracts and applications, land disputes and treaty rights,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Oneida Reservation Business Committee requests adequate legal representation for said Committee and it's individual Tribal members through funding from the Wisconsin Council on Criminal Justice.
