

- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a duly recognized Tribal government in accordance with the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 and,
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribal Business Committee is eligible to contract or receive grants from the Bureau of Indian Affairs under the authority of PL-638.
- NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Business Committee hereby applies for \$1,995 of forestry development funds to complete a reforestation project on Oneida Tribal owned lands.
