## Resolution # 09-02-98-A

### RESOLUTION FOR EMERGENCY AMENDMENT TO ONEIDA TRIBAL SANITARY DISTRICT ORDINANCE

WHEREAS the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee finds an immediate need to amend the Oneida Tribal Sanitary District Ordinance because it is necessary for the preservation of public health, safety and welfare of the reservation to include collection of solid waste refuse and recyclable material within the exterior boundaries of the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee finds that an amendment to the Oneida Tribal Sanitary District Ordinance is in the best interest of the public.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Tribal Sanitary District Ordinance is amended as follows:

At Article I.B., at the end of the last sentence, add the following which states:

It is further the purpose of this ordinance to include safe collection of solid waste refuse and recyclable material.

At Article II.B.13., add a new paragraph numbered II.B.13.g., which states:

To contract and/or provide for safe collection of solid waste refuse and recyclable material and to charge and/or seek grants for the same.

At Article II.B.13., add a new paragraph numbered II.B.13.h., which states


Establish rates and charges for collection of solid waste refuse and recyclable material for tribal residences within the exterior boundaries of the Oneida Reservation whether on fee or trust lands, and to charge tribal members and tribal entities for such services provided.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Oneida Utilities Commission will recognize and give credit to any tribal member who had paid for collection of solid waste refuse and recyclable material to another government so long as the tribal member provides proof of payment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said emergency amendments be in force and effect from the date of this resolution and will expire in six months thereof, unless time is extended by the Oneida Business Committee, or a permanent amendment replaces this emergency amendment.

#### CERTIFICATION

I, the undersigned, as Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee, hereby certify that the Oneida Business Committee is composed of nine (9) members of whom five (5) members constitute a quorum. 7 members were present at a meeting duly called, noticed and held on the 2nd day of September, 1998; that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by a vote of 6 members for 0 members against, and 1 members not voting; and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
