

## RESOLUTION # 9-06-00-E REGARDING PARDON OF JOEY S. CORNELIUS

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian

Government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe

of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article

IV., Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal

Council, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Screening Committee has presented a Pardon Petition on behalf of

Joes S. Cornelius, and

WHEREAS, the requirements of the Oneida Pardon Ordinance and Oneida Pardon

Procedures Policy have been fulfilled, and

WHEREAS. the Oneida Screening Committee hereby recommends <u>DENYING</u> the

pardon petition of <u>Joev S. Cornelius</u>, Petitioner.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: The Oneida Business Committee by this resolution hereby:

DENIES the Pardon of <u>Joev S. Cornelius</u>, Petitioner, and notifies the Petitioner that he/she may request another pardon after one (1) year from the date of certification of this document.
