Resolution 9-7-83-A

Request for Bureau of Indian Affairs to Place Tribally Owned Fee Land Into Trust Status

- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee authority to exercise the enumerated powers of the Oneida Constitution, Article IV, as amended, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as:

All that part of Claim 107 lying East and South of the highway passing through said claim; AND all of Claim 110 except the premises conveyed to St. Joseph's Congregation in Volume 183 of Deeds page 333 and Volume 527 of Deeds page 299, Outagamie County, Wisconsin Registry; All of said properties being in Township 23 North Range 19 East, Outagamie County, Wisconsin. Subject to easements and restrictions of record containing 69 acres.

WHEREAS, the above parcel is needed in Trust Status for the following purposes:

to expand the Tribal farm plan

to further protect the Conservancy area set aside by order of the General Tribal Council

to establish an area for tree planting

to provide an additional hunting and fishing area for Tribal members

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee certifies that the local property taxes due on this parcel will be paid for the year prior to Trust placement,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby requests the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs to initiate and carry out the process required to place the above parcel in Trust for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
