Present: Chairman Julius Danforth, Vice Chair Irene Moore, Secretary Eva Danforth

Special meeting called to order at the home of Irene Moore by Chairman Julius Danforth to make plans for the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Conference at Lac Du Flambeau. Council discussed the proposed bills concerning Indians in the state in regards to game rights, operation of Food Stamp pertaining to reservations, formation of Indian Affairs Committee in Senate and Assembly of the State Legislature, Operation Bootstrap and Repeal of the Wisconsin Wild Rice Bill.

Mrs. Moore and Julius Danforth said they would go as delegates for the Oneida Tribe; Mrs. Moore said she would go without any expenses as they could get a ride with Carl Bruno from the state welfare department but council agreed to give Julius Danforth \$10.00 toward expenses.

A motion was made by Irene Moore to this effect, seconded by Eva Danforth. Carried. Council agreed to donate their time for this meeting.

Motion by Irene Moore to adjourn. Seconded by Eva Danforth. Carried.
