### **POSITION SUMMARY**

Responsible for maintenance projects at various Tribal Buildings to include building repairs, painting, building remodeling and completion of assigned projects. Responsible for completing work reports daily regarding time, date, materials used, etc.. Continuation of this position is contingent upon funding allocations.

- 1. Responsible to oversee/mentor the maintenance work of less experienced staff.
- 2. Complete assigned Tribal maintenance projects to include, but not limited to; building repairs, painting, building remodeling, plumbing, carpentry or electrical projects.
- 3. Complete daily work reports regarding time, date, materials used, etc.
- 4. Responsible for preventive maintenance work of Tribal Buildings.
- 5. Shovel, clean, remove snow and upkeep of grounds in winter.
- 6. Assist with custodial and grounds-keeping responsibilities when needed.
- 7. Maintain inventory supplies, order as needed/required.
- 8. Attend extensive training during and after probationary period and attend in-service meetings.
- 9. Responsible for Maintenance Supervisor responsibilities in their absence.
- 10. Contribute to a team effort and accomplish related results as required.
- 11. Adhere to all Tribal Personnel Policies and Procedures, Tribal Standard Operating Procedures, and Area and Program Strategic Plans and Policies.
- 12. Maintain strict department security, confidentiality, and quality to meet professional standards of the department.
- 13. The above duties and responsibilities are not an all inclusive list but rather a general representation of the duties and responsibilities associated with this position. # PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS/WORK ENVIRONMENT:
