- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin has received notice from the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council that the termination date of the current Federal Emergency Employment Act contract is November 14, 1972, and
- WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin are in need of employment for members of the Tribe, who are unemployed and under employed, and
 - HEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin desire the following types of positions under the Emergency Employment Act and in the order of priority as listed,
 - 1. Director Manager of Indian activities of the Oneida Indian Center \$8,320.00 annually
 - ? Head Carpenter Home Repair Program \$8,320.00 annually
 - 3. Housing Authority Clerk \$4,992.00 annually
 - 4 Two Carpenter Helpers \$4,972.00 each, annually
 - 5. Oneida C.A.P. Secretary-Receptionist \$4,200.00 annually
 - 6. Custodian Oneida Indian Center \$4,972.00 annually
 - 7 Two Maintenance Men Housing Project Sites 1 and 2 \$4,972.00 each, annually.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this committee in regular session assembled, hereby requests the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council to fund the above mentioned positions, under a New Emergency Employment Act contract.
