Resolution 10-05-70-B Apprenticeship Project

Whereas, the Great Lakes Inter-Tribal Council representing the ten communities and tribes within the State of Wisconsin has sponsored the Pre-Apprenticeship Program since June of 1969

Whereas, the project has provided a needed outlet for all Indians in the State of Wisconsin to gain skills through apprenticeship training

Whereas, no opportunity or program of this type existed previously

Whereas, 126 trainees entered the program during the first year of operation, of which 85 were placed on jobs of their choice and in areas they desired

Whereas, 70 trainees of the total were in apprentice able trades and approximately 15 percent wer direct job placements

Whereas in 1969 this project received the endorsement of the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, Louis Bruce

Whereas, the continuity of the program was interrupted because of prolonged difficulty in gaining approval and funding for a new contract

Now Therefore Be It Resolved, that each member tribe or band acting in concert do hereby resolve and recommend that the Pre-apprenticeship project be designated as a permanent program.

I, the undersigned, as secretary of the Oneida Business Committee, hereby certify that the Oneida Business Committee is composed of 9 members of whom 5 constitute a quorum were present at a regular meeting held on the 5^{th} day of October, 1970, that the foregoing resolution was duly adopted at such meeting by a vote of 7 for, 0 against and 0 abstaining and that said resolution has not been rescinded or amended in any way.
