- the <u>Oneida</u> Tribe meets all requirements for Tribal Membership pursuant to Article II, Section 1, b of the Constitution of the National Congress WHEREAS. of American Indians; and
- NOV, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the <u>Oneida Business Committee</u>, which is the official governing body of the above named Tribe, hereby authorizes <u>Purcell Powless</u> who is the principal official of the Tribe, to take the necessary action to place the Tribe in Membership in NCAI; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that tribal funds in the amount of \$1,000,00, based on the Trib. Membership dues schedule of the NCAI By-Laws (Article III, Section 1, b) author to be paid for such Tribal Membership in NCAI; and
- BE T FURTHER RESOLVED that, based on membership of 8,879 persons, as verified by the records of Ashland Agency, the Tribe shall have 180 votes in accordance with Article IV, Section 3 of the NCAI Constitution; and
- BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that pursuant to Article V, Section 2 of the NCAI Constitution, the Tribe desgnates the following named person(s) as Delegate and Alternate Delegat and instructs them to become individual Member(s) in Good Standing in order to fulfill their responsibilities as Official Delegates to the National Congress of American Indians.
