- WHEREAS, A coordinated and current economic development program is essential for the maintenance and improvement of the quality of life on the Oneida Reservation of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribal Planning and Economic Development Offices were instructed to update the Tribal Economic Development Base Plan for 1977-799 and subsequent updates to that plan, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee formed an OEDP subcommittee to participate in and review the preparation of this document, and
- WHEREAS, the OEDP subcommittee recommends the revised Economic Development Plan contained herein.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida Business Committee hereby approves the 1985-87 Overall Economic Development Plan Update for the Oneida Reservation.
