

RESOLUTION NO. 10-15-79 F

WHEREAS, Mark A. Powless, and his wife Debra Powless, both Tribal Members, are the lessees on Lease No. covering Oneida Tribal land described as follows;

A parcel of land within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 11, T. 23N., R. 18E., 4th P.M., Wisconsin, more particularly described as follows: Commencing at the SE corner of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, thence due North 330.0 ft.; thence due East 264.0 ft.; thence due South 330.0 ft.; thence due West 264.0 ft.; to the place of beginning, containing 2.0 acres more or less, subject to all valid rights of way of record.

WHEREAS, Mark A. and Debra Powless, Tribal members, desire to assign their leasehold interest in said Lease No. , to the Green Bay Credit Union of Green Bay, Wisconsin, to develop the leasehold premises, in the amount of

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Oneida Business Committee in regular session assembled, that the request of Mark A. & Debra Powless to assign their Lease No. , to the Green Bay Credit Union of Green Bay, Wisconsin, is approved and submitted to the Great Lakes Agency for approval in accordance with regulations covering assignments of leases and the Chairman and the Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are authorized to sign the assignment documents on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
