

RESOLUTION # <u>10-21-98-A</u> Tiger Woods Foundation Resolution

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governmental body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the priority of the Oneida Tribe is to protect, maintain and build a solid educational foundation by addressing human needs of all members throughout the circle of life, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe, through the Oneida Parks and Recreation Area/Prevention Program and the Tiger Woods Foundation would like to further develop the Oneida Lacrosse Youth Program, and
- WHEREAS, that Oneida Tribe believes that the Oneida Family will be strengthened by promoting the overall cultural, educational and prevention needs of the Oneida Community for the next seven generations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin in partnership with the Tiger Woods Foundation authorizes and submits this culturally based community project to further develop the Oneida Lacrosse Youth Program to support the development of self-esteem, life skills, and positive values of our youth through cultural activities, inter generational relationships and physical fitness.
