

October 24, 1962

Special meeting held at Oneida CC Bldg. with Mr. E.J. Riley.

Mr. Riley read a memorandum to Committee in regard to 180 new enrollments which have been added to the roll and advised that the committee should review the rolls and add that some notations were attached to certificates as was necessary to explain any questions involved.

To get records straight – be sure to include minutes along with birth certificates. Mr. Riley explained that children from Indian communities or confines of a Indian reservation – eligible for state and federal land are entitled to go to government schools. Be sure (unreadable). Alice Louise – Florence Ruth, Aruelia. Edgar Charles Smith - only one not on official roll.

Mr. Riley said he would take back roll, make it identical to Agency roll.

Roll book shall be back at Oneida a week from Friday. Unclaimed checks still available as far as Mr. Riley knows and is not in name of Oneida but individual. Under new law people have 6 years to claim it, if not it will be credited to Oneida Tribe.

Discussed lease for Mrs. Cattrell and tribe. Secretary advised Mr. Riley she had supporting minutes at present and this business was taken care of.

Riley advised Mrs. Moore that his office would inform us when the Relocation vocational McCloud will be out.

Stated he would check on Casper King former Emma Summers allotment Earl Cornelius – Sister Alice would have to have statement from Earl that he wants to have it. Mr. Riley advised to give minimum acreage until they see fit to have more.

Mr. Riley made note of Sec. request for land blanks and agreement papers. Suggestion by Oscar Archiquette for General Tribal Council meet to act for Committee to money from Rehab fee and to cover expenses of compiling annuity. Motion to adjourn by Eva Danforth, seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.
