

AUTHORIZATION TO APPROVE ASSIGNMENT OF MORTGAGE INTEREST TO GMAC COMMERCIAL MORTGAGE SECURITIES FOR WESTWIND PROPERTY

- WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States of America; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and
- WHEREAS the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1, of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS, Oak Ridge Plaza, Inc., is a lessee in Master Ground Leases with the Oneida Nation as Lessor for the properties commonly referred to as Westwind, Sam's/Walmart or Carlton properties; and
- WHEREAS, ING Capital, Inc., is the lender to Oak Ridge Plaza, Inc., having a mortgage interest in said Westwind property; and
- WHEREAS, ING Capital, Inc., desires to assign its mortgage interest to GMAC Commercial Mortgage Securities, Inc., and said assignment will not effect the interest of the Oneida Nation; and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Nation gives its consent for said assignment to mortgage interest to occur.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Oneida Business Committee authorizes two of four of its officers to sign the assignment of mortgage from ING Capital, Inc., to GMAC Commercial Mortgage Securities, Inc., on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
