- WHEREAS, THE ONEIDA TRIBE IS A PARTICIPANT IN THE NATIVE AMERICAN PROGRAMS, AND
- WHEREAS, THE ONEIDA TRIBE WELCOME THE OPPORTUNITY TO INVOKE THE SELF DETERMINATION POLICY,
- WHEREAS, THE ONEIDA TRIBE FIND THEMSELVES AT A GREAT DISADVANTAGE

  UNDER THE PRESENT ADMINISTRATIVE SET-UP OF NATIVE AMERICAN

  PROGRAMS,
- WHEREAS, THE ONEIDA TRIBE HAVE THE CAPABILITIES AND THE FACILITIES

  ADMINISTER ANY AND ALL PROGRAMS IN WHICH THEY ARE INVOLVED,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE ONEIDA TRIBE PETITION MR.

  ROBERT HOWARD TO ASSIST THE ONEIDA TRIBE IN THE ACQUISITION

  OF CONDUCT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THEIR OWN PROGRAMS, AND
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT THIS RESOLUTION BE SENT TO ALL PARTIES WOULD POSSIBLY BE OF ASSISTANCE IN ACQUIRING THESE PROGRAMS.
