

RESOLUTION 72-11-6-C

- WHEREAS The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin Business Committee is the governing body of the Oneida reservation and is authorized to correct any misuse of a lease agreement given to tribal members,
- WHEREAS any discrepancies in official Tribal Business brought to the attention of the Business Committee must be acted on,
- WHEREAS it appears that there is a discrepancy or misunderstanding in the implementation of the lease on the part of the lessee,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the lessee, Mr. Joseph Webster, is in violation of his lease, and is hereby directed to correct the violation,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the violation of the lease agreement is, the occupancy of Donald Smits, a non-tribal member, on tribal lands and is hereby directed to vacate the premises within 30 days of this date, November 9, 1972.
