

## **RESOLUTION # 11-06-96-B**

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1(c), of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 1(c) authorizes the Oneida Tribe of Indians to lease or otherwise encumber tribal lands, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin's Division of Land Management is responsible for managing all tribal real property assets, including leases, through rules and policies approved in Oneida Real Property Law; and

WHEREAS, King Dome, Inc. plans to construct and operate a Sport Center and Recreation Facility, and

WHEREAS, The Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin wishes to lease the following Described parcel to King Dome, Inc.: Part of Lot 14, recorded plat of Packerland Subdivision, (Volume 13, Plats page 54 Brown County Records), and part of Government Lot 3, Section 28, T24N-R20E, City of Green Bay, Brown Co, Wisconsin more fully described as follows: Commencing at the northeast of Lot 14, recorded plat of "Packerland Subdivision"; thence S2°39'08"W, 53.30 feet along the east line of said Lot 14; thence S16°06'35"W, 484.64 feet along said east line to the point of beginning; thence continuing S16°06'35"W, 60.46feet along said east line; thence S42°42'49"E, 266.66 feet along a northerly line of Volume 884, Records, page 136 Brown County Records, to the west right-of-way of Taylor Street; thence S16°07'30"W, 163.05 feet along said right-of-way; thence S89°29'05"W, 781.21 feet along the south line of said Volume 884, Records, page 136, to the east right-of-way of U.S.H. "41"; thence N2°40'35"E, 412.34 feet along said east right-of-way of U.S.H. "41"; thence N89°29'05"E, 643.12 feet to the point of beginning. Parcel contains 304,907 feet/7.00 acres more or less.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Business Committee does hereby approve the lease to King Dome, Inc. For the purpose of construction and management of a Sports Center and Recreation Facility, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that Chris Doxtator, Land Management Director, or her designee, be authorized to execute said lease agreement on behalf of the Oneida Tribe.
