
RESOLUTION 11-17-04-D Alcohol Sales at West Mason Street Casino

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council has been delegated the authority of the Constitution of the Oneida Nation of Indians of Wisconsin, and,
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee may be delegated duties and responsibilities by the General Tribal Council and is at all times subject to the review powers of the General Tribal Council, and,
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Alcohol Beverage Licensing Law was adopted by the Oneida Business Committee by Resolution, and,
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee may grant a license to sell alcohol beverages through a resolution pursuant to Article 59.4-4, of the Oneida Alcohol Beverage License Law, and,
- WHEREAS,** the West Mason Street Casino, by Oneida Bingo and Casino, has satisfied the requirements of the Oneida Alcohol Beverage Licensing Law, including the procurement of a license to sell alcohol by the local municipality, the City of Green Bay.
- WHEREAS,** Oneida Bingo and Casino has requested that the Oneida Business Committee grant it a license to sell alcohol beverages at the West Mason Street Casino location.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: Oneida Bingo and Casino may sell alcohol beverages in accordance with the Oneida Alcohol Beverage Licensing Law and the prevailing laws of the local municipality, the City of Green Bay, Wisconsin, to be issued by the Oneida License Department.
