proceedings in a Tribal court or any other administrative body, and

WHEREAS: The Oneida Tribe is without a Tribal court.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Oneida Child Protective Board be the ad-

ministrative body vested with authority over child custody proceed-

ings, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the following two Tribal members be appointed to the Child Protective Board for a period of one year, commensing on the date this resolution is approved.
