
Resolution Allowing the Non-Indian Spouses of Indians Eligible for Services at the Oneida Community Health Center to Receive Health Services at the Oneida Community Health Center

- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin realizes that the availability of quality health care is vital to its members and their families; and
- WHEREAS,** the Indian Health Care Improvement Act provides the authority for the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin to provide health services to the non-Indian spouses of Indians eligible for services at the Oneida Community Health Center; and
- WHEREAS,** the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin desires to make direct care health services available to the non-Indian spouses of such eligible Indians on a fee for service basis.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that non-Indian spouses of Indians eligible for services at the Oneida Community Health Center, shall be eligible, as a class, to receive direct care health services at the Oneida Community Health Center on a fee for service basis.

CERTIFICATION
