

RESOLUTION #11-23-94-B

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and a treaty tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, there is a critical need to govern the removal of persons appointed and elected to serve the Oneida Nation of Wisconsin on boards, committees and commissions, including the Oneida Business Committee, and

WHEREAS, there is a critical need to consolidate all current Removal Ordinances into a single location, along with updating them to fit the current structure of the Oneida Nation government, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide protection to the rights of those being removed through due process, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to provide a forum for the gathering of all information necessary to make an informed and proper judgement as to whether removal is necessary.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Business Committee hereby adopts the Removal Law for an emergency Interim Basis for six (6) months as sanctioned by the Oneida Administrative Procedures Act, Article VI, Section A.2.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Business Committee hereby repeals Business Committee Resolution 3-8-85-A.
