BC Resolution # <u>11-25-98-A</u> Resolution Adopting the Probation and Parole Regulations

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the duly recognized governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of the Wisconsin, and

- WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council has been delegated the authority of the Constitution of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee may be delegated duties and responsibilities by the Oneida General Tribal Council and is at all times subject to the review powers of the Oneida General Tribal Council, and
- WHEREAS, the Probation and Parole Department was created by the Oneida Tribe to allow members of the Oneida Tribe who are under court supervision to be supervised by the Oneida Tribe, and
- WHEREAS, the Probation and Parole Department has developed regulations which will begin the implementation of the supervisory responsibilities pending the completion of any necessary agreements with the State of Wisconsin, and
- WHEREAS, the Probation and Parole Regulations have been presented for Public Hearing on August 20, 1998 and the comments have been considered by the Probation and Parole Department and through Attorney Review, and
- WHEREAS, the Legislative Operating Committee has approved forwarding this to the Oneida Business Committee for consideration,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Probation and Parole Regulations are adopted for implementation in 90 days, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Probation and Parole Department is directed to report on the final steps necessary for implementation of these regulations to the Legislative Operating Committee within 60 days.
