RESOLUTION # 11-29-95-C

WHEREAS the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Lora a tribal member and Theodore Waupekenay, a non-tribal member, have made application for a long-term lease for residential purposes; and

WHEREAS, the tribal land selected is described as follows:

Parcel A: Part of the SE½SE½, Section 11, T24N-R19E, Town of Hobart, Brown County, Wisconsin, more fully described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner, Section 11, T24N-R19E; thence N0°00'00"W, 1322.44 feet to the northeast corner of SE½SE½, said Section 11; thence S85°13'53"W, 982.76 feet along the north line of said SE½SW½, also being the centerline of Sunlite Drive, to the point of beginning; thence S0°44'44"E, 270.72 feet along the west line of the recorded plat of Clear View Subdivision 3rd Addition; thence S86°38'28"W, 253.13 feet; thence N4°14'25"W, 263.84 feet of the north line of the SE½SE½, Section 11, T24N-R19E; thence N85°13'53"E, 269.61 feet along said north line, also being the centerline of Sunlite Drive, to the point of beginning.

Parcel contains 69,794 square feet/1.60 acres, more or less, to center line of Sunlite Drive.

Parcel contains 63,140 square feet/1.45 acres, more or less, to 24.75 foot right-of-way of Sunlite Drive.
