WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe wishes to exchange a parcel of tribal land described as Lot 20, Sec. 12, T. 23N., R. 19E., 4th P.M., Brown County, Wisconsin, containing 10 acres, more or less to the Seymour Community School District for a parcel including buildings thereon known as the Chicago Corners School, described as the west 282 feet of the south 463 feet of Gov't Lot 7, Sec. 18, T. 23N., R. 19E., 4th P.M., Cutagamie County, Wisconsin, containing 3 acres, more or less; and

WHEREAS, the tribal land is appraised at \$12,000.00 and the Chicago Corners School property is appraised at \$30,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe will use the Chicago Corners School for tribal and community activities;

BE IT RESOLVED BY this Council in regular session assembled that since the land exchange is in the best interests of the tribe, conveyance be made to the Seymour Community School District of the above-described 10-acred directed Described Tribel Contents and Secretary are thereby districted of fixed are sign the legal documents required in connection with the conveyance; and that the property of the legal documents required in connection with the conveyance; exchange and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Omeida Tribe hereby accepts title to the 3-acre parcel known as the Chicago Corners School and that title be taken in the name of The United States of America in trust for the Omeida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
