RESOLUTION NO. 12-18-96-E

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian government and Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, Donald Q. Doxtator #1592 and Sharon S. Doxtator, a non-tribal member, residing at 4890 Countyline Road, Oneida, WI 54155, has submitted an application for a long-term lease for residential purposes, more particularly described as follows:


A parcel of land within the NW1/4SW1/4 Section 10, T24N., R19E., more particularly described as: beginning at the NW corner of said NW1/4SW1/4; thence East 330 ft; thence South 264 ft; thence West 330 ft; thence North 264 ft; to the point of beginning, containing 2.0 acres, subject to valid right-of-way of record, if any.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Committee in Regular session assembled, hereby requests the Superintendent, Great Lakes Agency, to review and approve the lease in accordance with the Act of August 9, 1955 (69 Stat. 539), as amended, 25 USC 415, for the above-described land with a 25-year term which shall automatically and without notice renew for an additional term of 25 years, annual rent due at 1/2 fair market rental, to be determined by an appraisal, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairwoman and Secretary of the Oneida Business Committee are hereby authorized to execute lease documents for and on behalf of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin.
