Special meeting called to order by Chairman Julius Danforth to discuss the business of semi-annual meeting on Monday January 1, 1962.

Discussion was held concerning the Oneida roll in regard to bringing it up to date.

Council decided it would be discussed at semi-annual meeting and that Mr. Riley would be again consulted about it.

Council agreed that Mr. Riley should be consulted about the former James Skenandore estate in regards to leasing it or find out if it could be let out as an assignment.

Secretary was advised to report on recent correspondence from lawyers in regards to progress of tribal claims.

Letter was read from Ed LaPlante informing Irene Moore of article in Milwaukee Journal referring to a petition to President Kennedy on behalf of tribal claims being sponsored by Mr. Oscar Archiquette. Council discussed the subject pro and con and had heard nothing of the petition prior to this. So it was decided that council should contact lawyers and find out what they thought about this action in fairness to them.

Motion was made by Althea Schuyler to authorize Irene Moore to call the lawyers in view of the time element so as to have some report in time for semi-annual meeting and also notify Mr. Riley of same. Seconded by Eva Danforth. Carried.

Motion by Eva Danforth to adjourn. Seconded by Althea Schuyler. Carried.
