RESOLUTION # 12-27-95-A

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Support Program of the Oneida Nation Social Services Department is a provider of services to poverty and low-income eligible tribal members and administers federal and state welfare programs within the Oneida Reservation, and


WHEREAS, the federal and state funding of certain welfare assistance programs will either be eliminated or substantially reduced as of January 1, 1996 and the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is eligible to apply for other funding allotments which will assure the provision of basic medical relief to needy Indians,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin make application to the State of Wisconsin, Department of Health and Social Services, Division of Community Support for a Tribal Medical Relief Block Grant pursuant to Chapter HSS 211.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Oneida Tribal Chairwoman, or the Vice Chair, is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract and any amendments thereto.
