WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin is a federally recognized Indian Government and a Treaty Tribe recognized by the laws of the United States, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida General Tribal Council is the governing body of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has been delegated the authority of Article IV, Section 1 of the Oneida Tribal Constitution by the Oneida General Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, the Oneida Tribe has acquired in fee status the following parcel described as: Roy K. & Lida H. Metoxen Property

WHEREAS, the parcel is described as follows:

Part of Lots 3 and 2, Section 1, T23N-R19E, Town of Hobart, Brown
County, Wisconsin, more fully described as follows:

Commencing at the North ½ Corner, Section 1, T23N-R19E; thence N89p17'34"E, 290.27 feet along the north line of the Northeast ½, said Section 1, to the point of beginning; thence continuing N89p17'34"E, 208.03 feet along said north line to the west line of Lot 2, said Section 1; thence S0p12'36"W, 1127.78 feet along said west line; thence S86p00'19"W, 208.56 feet along the south line of Lot 2 and 3, said section 1; thence N0p12'36"E, 1139.74 feet to the north line of the Northeast ½, Section 1, T23N-R19E; and the point of beginning.

Parcel contains 235,823 square feet/5.41 acres, to the centerline of Edgar Drive.

Parcel contains 230,674 square feet/5.30 acres, more or less to existing 24.75 foot right-of-way.
