R E S O L U T I U N 12-28-77

- WHEREAS, the General Tribal Council of the Oneida Tribe of Indians of Wis., Inc. has delegated to the Oneida Business Committee the Constitutional authority to exercise the powers of Article IV, as amended, and
- WHEREAS, the Oneida Business Committee has determined that a regular commercial loan of \$250,000 at 9 3/4% interest from the Kellogg Bank will assist the administration of the Oneida Nursing Home as follows:

Nursing Home Construction \$115,000 Nursing Home Operation δ ,000 Nursing Home Start up & Equip. 30,000 OTDC Nursing Home cost overrun 97,000

Total \$250,000

and,

- WHEREAS, 90% of the loan is guaranteed by the Bureau of Indian Affairs Loan Guarantee Program, and
- WHEREAS, the repayment schedule is equitable and feasible,
- NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Uneida Tribe of Indians of Wisconsin, Inc. by the Oneida Business Committee supports the loan contract terms and provisions which are incorporated by reference to this resolution,
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committments from the Oneida Tribal Development Corporation and the Oneida Nursing Home be formalized immediately with Kellogg Bank.
