

ONEIDA TRIBE OF INDIANS OF WISCONSIN

Minutes of the Tribal Meeting held at the Epworth Hall, Oneida
Reservation, January 23, 1937

Meeting called to order at 2:00 o'clock p.m. by the newly elected Chairman, Morris Wheelock. He thanked the voters of the Tribe for the support they gave him at the polls and promised to perform the duties of chairman of the Tribe to the best of his ability.

The Executive Board were called on to speak and each one responded with thanking the voters.

The business transacted were as follows:

The above named persons were admitted to the Tribe, and there names shall be placed on the Tribal Roll as per article II Section I, par. A & B , Sec, 2, of the Constitution and Bylaws.

Application for admittance to the Tribe by Marialls Turner and John Turner Jr. was tabled to a later date.

Supt. Christy of Tomah School shall be informed of the new members and request that he place their names on the annuity roll of the Tribe.

A general disscussion of the following:

Lace work for the Oneida women to provide employment for them.

All Indian projects on the order of W.P.A.

How soon will the Indians be assigned to land under option, so that they can start to plant.

Miscellaneous business and correspondance left to the Executive Board.

Meeting adjourned at 4:45 P.M. subject to the call of the Executive Board.
