Meeting of the Executive board was held at the relief office, with six members present.

The Chairman Morris Wheelock suggested that a new officer' be appointed to fill the vacancy of Anderson Skenandore's death.

Chauncey Adams and Anderson Summers were nominated. Chauncey got majority votes and was elected chairman for the credit committee.

Dave Skenandore was nominated with opposition to fill the unexpired term of Chauncey Adams.

The chairman read a resolution sent out by Mr. McKinsey and which is to be approved by the General Tribal Council. Members decided to have a general meeting on the evening of Dec. 10, 1937 with notices to be posted a few days before.

Board meeting adjourned until Nov. 22, 1937 to be held at home of Lydia W. Powless.
